- **Overall demonstrating a true partnership of working with children, young people, families and carers.**
- **No longer than 20 minutes**

This event will be of interest to social work practitioners, managers, learning and development officers and policy makers. Alongside the presentations from practitioners there will also be the opportunity to hear from a Panel, who will be able to answer questions and bring together the learning from the event.
